After Half term we will be changing our learning theme to 'Growing' (More information on our 'Learning Themes' page.)

As part of this work, we will be asking the children to find out about how their own family- the people in it, and how those people have grown and changed since they were babies.

This will develop your child's *Personal, Social and Emotional, Language and Communication, and The World Around Us* skills and learning, all of which we would be doing at school as part of our pre-school curriculum.
